New Attractions at EDELWIES Nature and Amusement Park Season Opening on 9 July 2021

EDELWIES Nature and Amusement Park welcomes the new season on 9th July with new attractions and a wider range of services. In an idyllic location in the hilly foothills of the Bavarian Forest, visitors can expect an unforgettable experience for the whole family. Exciting barrier-free attractions are now ready to enjoy, such as the Hell Coaster, Maypole Flyer, Super Swing (new), Dual Wheel (new), Trampoline Park, Tractor Ride, Moose Trail, Pirate Ship, Lighthouse Slide , Children's Chain Carousel, Motor Skills Facilities (new), Water Playground and many more.

Over a total area of 145 hectares, with the amusement park covering 26 hectares, Edelwies combines the exciting and imaginative world of an amusement park integrated harmoniously into the natural landscape with a secluded nature park.

The park has been extensively expanded since 2020. For example, a completely new section of the park has been created towards the Dießenbach river, which was already extensively renatured last year. In the terraced grounds, which have been designed with great care, there is a newly-built entrance area, the market square with its food cart, small ponds, several wooden bridges over the stream, glass art, circular paths, lots of places to sit and lounge, and a variety of playground equipment. The trampoline court has been expanded again and we have increased the car parking facilities.

In the hillside nature park is the charming sight of the Dießenbach river flowing through its own gorge. Our own forest of over 100 hectares with hiking trails is perfect for long walks and exploring the landscape. During the summer holidays we will open our new, spacious, animal enclosures, designed specifically to house alpacas, Bennet's kangaroos and meerkats.

The park's main theme is the forest, something which has always been extremely important in our culture, especially in myths, legends and fairy tales. The idea of the forest, its animals and its plants therefore dominates many of the attractions. An overall focus on ecology and sustainability is one of our main interests.

Of course, there are plenty of refreshment options and the Edelwies Restaurant offers wide variety of delicious food and drinks. Opposite the Edelwies Restaurant there is now spectacular amphitheatre seating made from local granite for open-air cinema and other events.
